VISTOS: El DFL Nº 149 de 1981 del Ministerio de Educación y la Resolución Nº6 y N°7 de 2019 de la Contraloría General de la República.

CONSIDERANDO:

La importancia para la Universidad de Santiago de Chile de promover la cooperación académica e interinstitucional e internacional y fomentar las relaciones bilaterales de carácter académico.

RESUELVO:

APRUEBESE el convenio, suscrito entre la Universidad de Santiago de Chile y la Universidad Transilvania de Brasov, Rumania, con fecha 11 de diciembre de 2020 y cuyo texto es el siguiente:

Key Action 1 - Mobility for learners and staff Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility

Inter-institutional¹ agreement 20[21]-20[27]²

between institutions from Programme and Partner Countries³

[Minimum requirements]4

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. They commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects of the organisation and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits (or equivalent) awarded to students by the partner institution. The institutions also commit to sound and transparent management of funds allocated to them through Erasmus+.

- Accept all activities indicated in the learning agreement as counting towards the degree, provided these have been satisfactorily completed by the mobile student.
- Provide, free-of-charge, incoming mobile students and their sending institutions with transcripts in English or in the language of the sending institution containing a full, accurate and timely record of their achievements at the end of their mobility period.
- Support the reintegration of mobile participants and give them the opportunity, upon return, to build on their experiences for the benefit of the Institution and their peers.
- Ensure that staff are given recognition for their teaching and training activities undertaken during the mobility period, based on a mobility agreement.

- Provided support from Usach
 - Ensure equal academic treatment and services for incoming students, professors and the staff into the institution's everyday life and have appropriate mentoring and support arrangements as well as appropriate linguistic support for all of them.
 - Ensure recognition of the educational components and related credits, issuing transcript of records and diploma supplements of outgoing students.
 - Support the reintegration of outgoing participants and give them the opportunity, upon return, to build on their experiences for the benefit of the Institution and their peers.

4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given.
